## INCIDENT COMMAND FOR HIGHRISE OPERATIONS

This 2-day course is designed to assist emergency response officers who have responsibility for managing highrise incidents. This includes organizing resources, developing strategies, and managing tactical operations to protect life and to minimize damage during an incident. Students attending should have a working knowledge of the basic ICS organization; working knowledge of strategy and tactics for structural firefighting; knowledge of building construction; and understanding of the type of building systems existing in highrise buildings. Target Audience: Anyone who would serve as a Company Officer/Chief Officer in communities that have highrise buildings. Instructor will be Terry Clements, retired DC from Clearwater Fire Rescue.
