The Center for Leadership is designed to serve the educational needs of public safety professionals. The curricula of the courses offered by the Center will have a broad academic foundation with intensive practical application. The learning environment is designed to reinforce and expand the strengths of the leaders, while identifying, exploring, and addressing areas in need of development. Leaders will experience a supportive environment that is designed to create exemplary leaders with superior critical thinking skills.

Our first offering will be *Evolving Leaders in a Changing Environment*

This course will provide leaders with knowledge and skills in the following areas:

Organizational Behavior

Administrative Law

Community Relations

Administration and Management of Patrol Issues and Specialized Units

Practicum

This course is designed for new supervisors who desire to become exemplary leaders and skilled change agents within their organizations. The format for delivery of this course is a hybrid approach. Participants will engage in on-line curricula and interactive curricula delivered in a classroom environment. Participants will meet two days a month for a period of six months to complete the course.

The Practicum requires the leader to identify a significant challenge in his/her agency or another agency. This challenge can be a technological, environmental, staffing, budgetary, investigatory or any other challenge that if addressed, could positively affect the police agency. It is recommended that the leader's project is discussed with the police chief/sheriff of the agency to ensure their support, as the leader must implement this change.

This course will qualify for Bachelor level College Credit and total cost will be \$1800.
