- \***Rachel's Law** is an overview of the State of Florida requirements and procedures that a law enforcement agency must have in place when retaining confidential informants.
- \***Miranda** is an overview of U.S. Supreme Court cases that provide that prior to interrogation, a person in custody be advised of certain specified legal rights.

Individuals or agencies may register their officers between Jan. 16 and May 4, 2012. Once registered, you will receive an e-mail confirmation, directions and user id to access training.



**The registration fee is \$30.00 per person.** The training hours are approved by Florida Criminal Justice Standards & Training Commission for two hours of mandatory retraining hours. For officers taking this course outside of the State of Florida, please check with your state for retraining hour requirements. There is an assessment test at the end of this course. To receive a certificate of completion, you must successfully complete the exam. Once you successfully complete the exam you will be able to print the certificate of completion. You will be given two opportunities to pass the test, after that the course will be closed and you will have to re-register to take the class again.
