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As a non-immigrant international student accepted for admission to St. Petersburg College you will be classified as a non-Florida student, and will be assessed out-of-state fees for the duration of your enrollment. An F-1 Student VISA is considered a temporary status.

The credit hour rate is \$352.29 per credit hour for Associate degree classes or English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program, and \$406.96 per credit hour for baccalaureate degree classes.

Each international student is expected to have sufficient funds to meet all personal and college expenses. Tuition payment will be due before the first day of class.

St Petersburg College requires you to have an equivalent yearly stipend (which is an estimate) broken down as follows: **Any special or lab fees are additional.**
