**2009-10 Selective Service Registration Information Sheet**

The Department of Education could not confirm that you are registered with the Selective Service Administration. To receive financial assistance, you must provide documentation to our office that you either are registered or were not required to register with the Selective Service Office. Please read the statements below to determine the category you belong to and which documentation you will need to turn in to prove your status. Once you have done so please submit the appropriate documentation to either the MySPC Answer Place or a Financial Assistance Services Office.

**Category A:**

I am a male U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, born after Dec. 31, 1959, who is 18, but not yet 26 years of age. I must register with the Selective Service. I will either provide a copy of my Selective Service Registration Card, a "Quick Response Letter" from the Selective Service verifying I am registered, or a printout of my registration from the Selective Service website [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov).

**Category B:**

I am a male U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, 26 years or older, born before December 31, 1959, who has **NEVER** registered with the Selective Service. You must submit the following documents to the MAP Center or a Financial Assistance Services Office:

- ✓ Advisory Opinion letter from the Selective Service. To receive an Advisory Opinion letter from the Selective Service System, please call 1-847-688-6888. You may also send a written request to the Selective Service System at P.O. Box 94638, Palatine, IL 60094-4638. Ask for a "status information" letter. You can download a premade request form and its instructions from <https://www.sss.gov/fsmen.htm>
- ✓ A detailed letter of explanation on why you did not register.

**Category C:**

If you do not fall into one of the following categories, you must be in category A or B and will be required to submit the documentation listed for each category.

- **I am a female** = submit a copy of your driver's license or birth certificate.
- **I have not reached my 18<sup>th</sup> birthday** = submit a copy of your driver's license or birth certificate.
- **I was born before 1960** = submit a copy of your driver's license or birth certificate.
- **I am in the Armed Services on Active Duty (not a veteran or in the reserves)** = submit a copy of your current active duty orders and your military ID card.
- **I am a noncitizen/citizen who entered the U.S. after I turned 26** = submit a copy of your I-94, I-551, or I-551C and a brief statement that you entered the U.S. and became a citizen after turning 26.
- **I am a noncitizen/citizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant and remained in the U.S. under the terms of that visa until after the age of 26** = Submit a copy of the I-94, I-551, I551C, or Visa and brief not explaining you situation.
- **I am a resident of the Federated States of Micronesia or the Marshall Islands, or permanent resident of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Island** = Submit proof of residency status.
