



College Placement Test

To qualify for SPC's Dual Enrollment, Early College or Early Admission programs you must have satisfactory scores (see score chart below) on either the SAT/ACT test or SPC's College Placement Test.

Steps to take the Placement Test

1. Choose a testing location nearest you and call for the time the test is offered.
2. [Apply to SPC](#) and click on "Apply for one of our high school programs." (Your completed application will generate your new student number, which is required before you take the test.)
3. Take the completed pink card and a valid photo ID (such as a driver's license, student ID or other state ID) to the testing center.
4. If you have a disability and require testing accommodations beyond extended time (test is not timed), [contact Accessibility Services](#) to make arrangements for accommodations.

NOTE: All testing is done in our testing lab on the computer and there are no time limits. The following items are **NOT** allowed in the testing area: calculators, dictionaries, cell phones, pagers, food, drinks, or hats.

(Based on qualifying test scores on ANY of the following tests)
 Scores used for course placement **must be under two years old**.
 SPC uses the highest scores from the Accuplacer, PERT, SAT and ACT administered within the last two years.

DE = Dual Enrollment – Qualifying scores needed only in the subject area of chosen course; however all subtests must be taken

ECP = Early College Program – Qualifying scores needed in all areas

EA = Early Admissions – Qualifying scores needed in all areas
