## Update on Training:

- a. It's been a struggle to find students all Spring, but we think we have enough for this summer's cohort. The AS Degree in Engineering Technology students at St. Petersburg College will be taking the MSSC class this summer. The MSSC certification articulates into 15 credits for Engineering Technology at SPC.
- b. We are sending an adjunct instructor to Michigan to a train the trainer for FANUC Robotics. We would like to have a 12 weeks robotic program offered in the fall.
- c. We have a set of novices for Mechatronics training for last fall that will be finishing up soon. Soon we will have the Round 1 TAACCCT curriculum for a one-year/ for-credit certification that we hope to be able to use for our workforce novices and incumbents.
- d. SPC is continuing to partner with Polk State College for incumbent workers and mechatronics training.

## Statewide job fair:

a. On April 22<sup>nd</sup> the FL TRADE Consortium held a statewide job fair that included all Florida TRADE colleges and their local CareerSources by having an event on or near the same date. In attendance for SPC were 17 employers, 11 staffing agencies, 6 training programs and 92 job seekers. We sent out a link to an online survey to everyone to ask them about feedback for the event.
