- BASDH Curriculum update- Siladie
  - Under our new curriculum, we had our first cohort complete their capstone in the fall semester, producing our first December graduates.
     These students began the program in January 2013, and we awarded 22 bachelor degrees in December 2014.
  - We had an uptick in enrollment for our January cohort of new students last January (2014) we had 18 new students, this January (2015) we accepted and enrolled 27 new students.
  - Our BASDH program had a booth at FDHA in Orlando in September to help with recruitment--Christine Patel reported enthusiastic interactions with many potential students.

     New practice management course- Dental Hygiene III

## Objectives:

- 1. The student will be introduced to practice management and will demonstrate skills by:
  - a. Identifying correct CDT codes
  - b. Discussing the rationale for business production goals
  - c. Determining a clinical day(s) worth of production
  - d. Identify supplies utilized by the dental hygienist in the dental hygiene treatment care plan
  - e. Performing cost analysis of the identified supplies utilized in the dental hygiene treatment care plan.
- 2. The student will demonstrate the role of interprofessional collaboration in dental hygiene care by:
  - a. Describing the inclusion of other medical disciplines in the treatment of the dental patient.
  - b. Defining and describing interdisciplinary relationships.
- 3. The student will demonstrate soft communication skills by:
  - a. Role playing clinical scenarios.
  - b. Utilizing critical thinking skills through clinical case studies.
- 4. The student will demonstrate the knowledge of table clinic presentations by:
  - a. Defining the steps of developing a table clinic presentation.
  - b. Identify and research topics of current interest.
- Change in effect for admission pre requisites requiring Microbiology to be part of the admission process as a pre entry course along with A & P I and A & P II.
  - This is being done to assist students success in the strenuous DH curriculum
- Questions for Committee:
  - Blood Pressure monitoring/screening in private practices- parameters?
