| Custom Textbooks           | Five custom textbooks/e-books and a handbook have been<br>developed by Pearson Higher Ed with input from staff. Two<br>upper division courses also have e-book access available as an<br>alternative to the Pearson printed texts. Students can purchase<br>the printed lower division books and e-book access codes, the<br>upper division access codes (or printed books) from the<br>bookstore using financial aid. They can also bypass the<br>bookstore and purchase through Angel if they do not need to<br>use their financial aid dollars. The electronic access gives the<br>students a "my search lab" and "research navigator" through<br>Pearson's content for two years. | There will be more custom<br>textbooks/e-books being<br>developed for next term for<br>upper division   |
| ECH Adjustments/Enrollment | ECH adjustments for all instructors will no longer be lowered<br>as a reflection of low enrollment, but can be raised for higher<br>enrollment. SPC administration wants all programs to have a<br>standard annual schedule that students can follow, ultimately<br>creating full classes. Most of the programs in the College of<br>Public Safety already have an annual plan.<br>Enrollment is up across SPC. Several programs have had a<br>marked increase (Criminal Justice, IT Security, and PSA upper<br>division). Productivity for the Allstate campus is 97%.   | Annual plans will be reviewed<br>as the various programs are<br>revamped.   |
