SPC administers CLEP examinations. Students who wish to take a CLEP exam must contact an [SPC testing center](#) to make an appointment. CLEP's are to be scheduled 24-48 hours before the test administration time.

Starting July 1, the CLEP registration fee increased to \$85 [when registering for a CLEP](#). The current fee is \$80.

In addition, SPC charges a \$15 proctoring fee the day of the exam.
