What is NIP?

The New Initiative Program, or NIP, as it is more commonly known, is a federally funded program dedicated to student success thru academic support for the pre-health and health education students

Why NIP?

Because graduates of these programs work in such critical occupations, the health education curriculums are quite demanding and require long hours of concentrated study. NIP provides a rich assortment of resources and services to help students meet this challenge.

How Does NIP help me be successful?

The tutors assist students when they've struggled to comprehend a concept or keep up with a class. In the great majority of the cases the student catches on or catches up.

What type of help is available?

NIP has a large selection of accessible review materials, including anatomical models, interactive software, handouts, videos, and student test banks.

Students may work one-on-one with a NIP staff to master principles of anatomy and physiology. The center also offers help to improve basic skills of mathematic, stress reduction and test taking skills. Students are also welcome to group study as well as review for lab practicals and tests. Appointments are encouraged, however walk-ins are always welcome.

What does it cost?

Nothing. NIP is supported by Carl D. Perkins Vocational Funds through the Florida Department of Education Workforce Division.
