

“Find it at SPC” using Google Scholar

St. Petersburg College Libraries, with help from our IT department, the [College Center for Library Automation](#), and Ex Libris [SFX technology](#), is now allowing Google Scholar to link to full-text articles that are within SPC library databases. This is an exciting development that allows researchers to utilize the familiar Google interface to find scholarly resources that might otherwise be hidden.

How does it work?

While on campus, “Find it at SPC” links will display automatically in a list of Google Scholar search results.

For example, visit <http://scholar.google.com> and search for “separation of powers.”



A list of results will display. Look for a relevant *Find it at SPC* link and click on it.

After clicking on the *Find it at SPC* link another page will display that provides options for locating the full-text of the article. Next, click on one of the *Go* buttons.

1. Visit <http://scholar.google.com>.
2. Click on *Scholar Preferences* to the right of the Search button.



3. Under Library Links enter *spc* and then click on the *Find Library* button.
