

# Basic Gang Investigator

## New Course Offering



**This 24 hour course is the first series of a three part investigator course. This basic course is designed for patrol officers, community policing officers and detectives that are new to a gang unit.**

**Officers that take the Basic Gang Investigator course will be eligible to take the Intermediate Gang Investigator course and the Advanced Gang Investigator course that will be scheduled at a later date. A written test will be given at the end of the course and a passing score of 80% is required to receive a certificate.**

### Course Instructors:

Ed oversees the statewide gang initiative and is a recognized subject matter expert by state court and the Department of Justice. Ed has been involved in investigating and dismantling gangs since 1988. Ed has experience in supervising and investigating all levels of gang crime including gang narcotics investigations, gang homicides, gang robbery and witness protection from gang intimidation. Additional experts in the field of gang investigation will be presenting in this course.**
