



BASIC HOSTAGE NEGOTIATIONS IN JAILS & PRISONS



The objective of this 40-hour salary incentive course is to improve the knowledge, skills and ability of correctional officers to interact with inmate hostage takers, suicidal individuals and persons who are emotionally distraught. The skills and contents taught will enhance officer strategies to successfully resolve hostage situations and minimize potential personal injury or loss of life.

C. Frank McClure served 24 years with the Atlanta Police Department. He became a member of the department's Hostage Negotiation Team at its inception in 1976 and was appointed Team Commander in 1979. He has also served as a captain with the Douglas County Sheriff's Office in Georgia.
