

# ON-LINE BURGLARY/TRESPASS

**available to take within the SPC semester**



On line burglary/trespass is an overview of the Florida State Statues pertaining to these laws. The lesson provides statutes and definitions. Law enforcement officers statistically spend a vast amount of time investigating burglary and trespass. It is imperative to have a sound understanding of the application of these statutes. The course covers pertinent case laws relating to both burglary and trespass.



Individuals or agencies may register their officers between May 4<sup>th</sup> and July 20. Once registered, you will receive an e-mail with directions and user id to access training. The process takes approximately 24 business hours.

**The registration fee is \$30.00 per person.** Florida Criminal Justice Standards & Training Commission approves the training hours for two hours of mandatory retraining hours. For officers taking this course outside of the State of Florida, please check with your state for retraining hour requirements. There is an assessment test at the end of this course. To receive a certificate of completion, you must successfully complete the exam with an 80%. Once you successfully complete the exam you will be able to print the certificate of completion. You will be given two opportunities to pass the exam, after that the course will be closed and you will have to re-register to take the class again.
