**Elder Abuse Investigations:** Agencies or individuals may register between 1/11/10 and 5/1/10. Once registered, you will receive a confirmation email. You will only be able to complete the course during the assigned semester which begins in January and ends May 1, 2010. Once you receive a confirmation letter there are no refunds. Please read the material before taking the test. You will need to receive an 80% to pass the test. You will be given only two chances to pass the test.
