Among the topics being focused are the standardized format for emergency plans; elements of emergency plans; factors affecting emergency situations such as riots, disturbances, and hostage situations; and management and leadership roles before, during and after emergencies.

Presenter Warden Rhodene Mathis has worked for the Florida Department of Corrections approximately 30 years. She began her career as a CO (Correctional Officer) in 1979 and moved thru the ranks over that time to Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain, Major, Colonel and Assistant Wardens at Lowell CI. In 2008 she became the Warden at Hillsborough CI, overseeing the safe operation, security and management of that facility.
