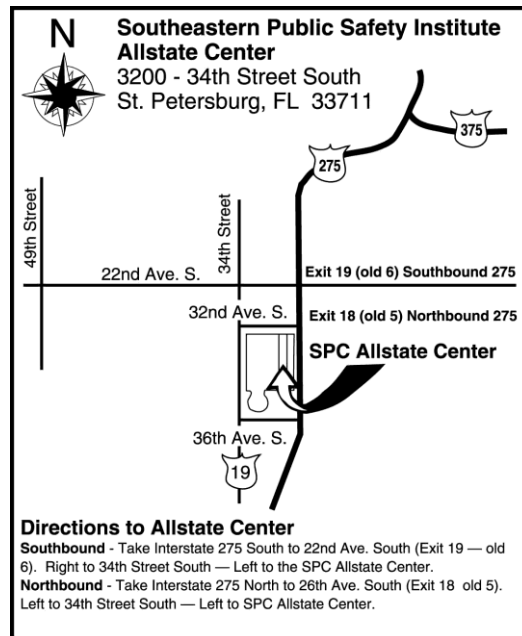
Program Presenter
