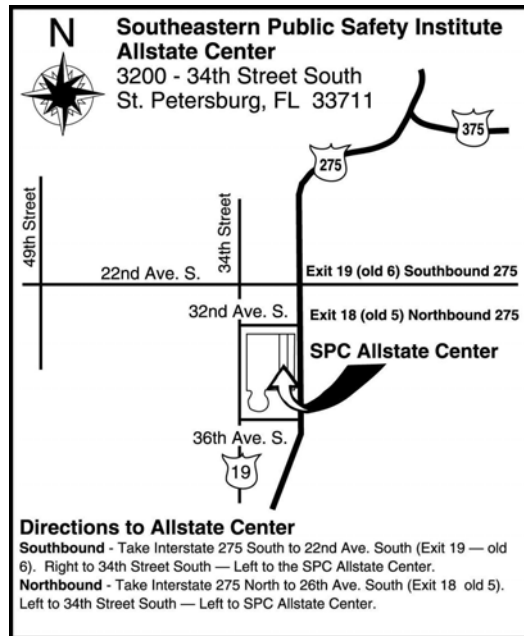
## Program Presenter
