This eight-hour introductory course teaches law enforcement officers how to develop the insight necessary for understanding why rapists do what they do. Officers examine typologies determined by research that is used to establish inductive and deductive criminal profiles. Officers are introduced to various skills necessary for uncovering the development and display of offender characteristics and traits, and learn investigative strategies for unsolved rapes and sexual assaults. Officers also learn how to ascertain whether a victim was specifically targeted for violence or randomly selected. Actual case studies illustrate the offender.

Presenter: William S. Crowder, Ph.D., Assistant Professor of Criminal Justice at Kennesaw State College, Certified Instructor, Army Colonel and U.S. Army Trainer. Crowder has written publications, papers and presentations.
