This 40-hour salary incentive course is designed to enhance the law enforcement, correctional and correctional probation officer's ability to deal with stressful situations that are inherent in the criminal justice profession. A general awareness of the causes and types of stress, as well as ways to resolve stress, should lead to more effective job performance. This course emphasizes application of stress resolution techniques, both personal and organizational including eight (8) hours of physical fitness training.

Workout attire [shorts, shirt, tennis shoes], two towels and a calculator.
