



BASIC HOSTAGE NEGOTIATIONS



The objective of this 40-hour course is to enhance the knowledge, skills and ability of attendees to interact with barricaded subjects, suicidal individuals and persons who are emotionally distraught. The skills and concepts taught in this course have proven to reduce citizen complaints in that they enhance the officer's ability to communicate with the public. Case studies and role playing are also reviewed.

C. Frank McClure served 24 years with the Atlanta Police Department. He became a member of the department's Hostage Negotiation Team at its inception in 1976, and was appointed Team Commander in 1979. In addition to the Atlanta police, he served as a captain with the Douglas County Sheriff's Office in Georgia.
