This course is taught by SPC, Associate Professor David Brumfield and SPC adjunct instructor, James R. Johnson. Mr. Brumfield received his crime scene training from Michigan State Police Crime Laboratory and was employed as a police officer for the State of Michigan for 20 years. Mr. Brumfield also spent 8 years with Pinellas County Sheriff's Office Forensic Section. Mr. Brumfield has instructed nationally and internationally and is a recognized expert witness in the field of forensics.

Mr. Johnson received his crime scene training from Pasco-Hernando Community College. He is a crime scene technician with New Port Richey Police Department. He is a Criminal Justice and Standards instructor who teaches forensic science throughout the state.
