



Intermediate Gang Investigator New Course Offering



This 24 hour course is the second in a series of a three part investigator course. The Intermediate course builds on the basic course and is designed for patrol officers, school resource officers, community policing officers, detectives and supervisors. Those attending the Intermediate Gang Investigator course should have a basic understanding of gang culture. A licensed psychologist will be exposing the mind set and culture of gang affiliation. Also, a defense attorney will be presenting strategies for court. This information will be vital to any investigator working to identify gang members and successfully prosecute those involved in gang activity. A written test will be given at the end of the course and a passing score of 80% is required to receive a certificate.

Course Lead Instructor:

The lead Instructor for this course is FDLE Agent, Ed DeVelasco. As an agent with FDLE, Ed is Statewide Coordinator for Gang Operation and Training. Ed oversees the statewide gang initiative and is a recognized subject matter expert by state court and the Department of Justice. Ed has been involved in investigating and dismantling gangs since 1988. Ed has experience in supervising and investigating all levels of gang crime including gang narcotics investigations, gang homicides, gang robbery and witness protection from gang intimidation. Additional experts in the field of gang investigation will be presenting in this course.
