Training Opportunity



All law enforcement officers should be knowledgeable about the process of internal affairs investigations. This training opportunity will provide the investigator and the officer with information on the latest legislative bills and court case rulings. The course will cover the Florida Police Officers Bill of Rights and the Garrity and Loudermill cases. The instructor will identify strategic steps needed to prepare for the investigation and interview. The course will cover the following topics: identifying allowable evidence, FDLE involvement in the investigation, the process of officer involved shootings, dealing with disruptive and uncooperative subjects, various forms of misconduct and the role of the representatives during the investigation.

SPC adjunct instructor, Attorney Kenneth Afienko, will teach this course. Mr. Afienko represents law enforcement officers on legal issues, pensions and contract negotiations.
