KINESIC INTERVIEWS

The Kinesic Interview technique is a comprehensive, coordinated approach to interviewing. You can learn to use the conscious and unconscious verbal and nonverbal behaviors of the interviewee to diagnose his or her emotional state. This helps you gain the truthful information you need, and achieve your information-gathering goals in a faster and more thorough manner. With few exceptions, your interviewees will show behavior that tells you if they are being "open" and "honest" or "evasive" and "untruthful". Their behavior also will alert you as to when they are ready to admit the truth.

The instructor for this class is Jerry Herren. Jerry is a retired Sex Crimes Detective with the Tampa Police Department having 22 years service and is currently a Detective Sergeant with the Seminole Police Department. He has instructed Advance Training Classes including Kinesics throughout the Southeastern United States and was a former partner with J & J Instructional Services.
