KINESIC INTERVIEWS

The Kinesic Interview technique is a comprehensive, coordinated approach to interviewing. You can learn to use the conscious and unconscious verbal and nonverbal behaviors of the interviewee to diagnose his or her emotional state. This helps you gain the truthful information you need, and achieve your information-gathering goals in a faster and more thorough manner. With few exceptions, your interviewees will show behavior that tells you if they are being "open" and "honest" or "evasive" and "untruthful". Their behavior also will alert you as to when they are ready to admit the truth.

SPC adjunct instructor, Mark Deasaro holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from St. Leo University. He served the City of St. Petersburg as a law enforcement officer for 25 years. During his tenure as a law enforcement officer, mark worked in the Investigative Service Bureau for twelve years. During his time as a detective Mark was assigned to major crimes and served on the Roger Homicide Task force. Mark is a past president of the Florida Homicide Investigators Association and the Pinellas County PBA. He is the co-creator of the Cold Case coalition of Tampa Bay and the co-creator and author of "The Out Cry Project", a community policing approach to handling unsolved homicides.
