New Type of Virtual Training

WebEx training is a virtual platform that you can access from your home or work computer. Once everyone is registered for the course, you will receive an e-mail with the WebEx link and phone number for the training.

Please log on to the site 15 minutes before the official course time. Through WebEx on your computer, you will have the ability to hear, communicate, observe and interact with the instructor.

The first course, Legal Updates, will cover legislative changes and laws that are pertinent to law enforcement officers. It will be taught by Assistant State Attorney Holly Grissinger, a prosecuting felony attorney and an Assistant County Court Director. Grissinger, a graduate of Stetson University, is an Adjunct Professor at SPC.
