



Narcotics & Dangerous Drugs Investigations New Course Offering



Narcotics & Dangerous Drugs Investigations is a 40 hour FDLE salary incentive course. The course is designed to provide an officer with limited drug investigation experience additional skills and knowledge needed to effectively investigate drug cases. There is a written exam at the end of the course and a score of 80% is required to pass this course. The course would benefit patrol officers, school resource officers, community policing officers and officers interested being assigned to a narcotics unit.

Course topics include:

- Trends and Recognition
- Information Analysis
- Case Development
- Post Arrest Strategy
- Investigative & Interview Techniques
- Case Documentation
- Evidence Collection
- Trial Preparation

Course Lead Instructor:

The lead instructor for this course is SPC adjunct instructor, Randy Keys. Randy retired from the Tampa Police Department as a master detective assigned to the Narcotics Unit. Randy served as a DEA Task Force Agent and is a graduate of the National Drug Enforcement Officers Academy. In 2009, Mr. Keys went to Afghanistan as a law enforcement advisor/subject matter expert for the United States Army. Mr. Keys has a BA in Criminal Justice from St. Leo College.
