Admissions Checklist

Students will be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Educational Studies at St. Petersburg College by submitting the following:

- ❑ Official transcripts showing completion of an A.A. degree or 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution and the following state-mandated prerequisites with a grade of “C” or better:
 - EDF 1005 Introduction to Education
 - EDF 2085 Teaching Diverse Populations
 - EME 2040 Introduction to Educational Technology
- ❑ Official transcripts from high school(s) (or GED). Students who have submitted transcripts that document a fully accredited associate’s, bachelor’s, or higher degree are not required to submit a high school transcript, unless it documents completion of 2 consecutive years of one foreign language.
- ❑ Official transcripts from all colleges attended.
- ❑ Completion of all college-preparatory coursework.
- ❑ Completion of a minimum of fifteen (15) semester hours of transferable [general education coursework](#).
- ❑ Cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.00 scale in all postsecondary coursework.
- ❑ SPC Application
 - New SPC students:
 - Go to [MySPC](#), click on the “Apply for Admission” link on the left side of the page, complete the online application, and pay the \$40 application fee.
 - Returning SPC students:
 - Logon to [MySPC](#) and complete the “Bachelor Programs” Application near the bottom of the page. Students who were last enrolled at SPC more than 12 months ago are required to verify their [residency](#) status for tuition purposes.

Additional information—not admissions criteria:

- ❑ Students who intend to pursue the Interdisciplinary Studies track should complete General Psychology (PSY 1012 or PSY 1020H) prior to beginning the program because it is a prerequisite for DEP 3305.
