 Admissions Checklist

Students will be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Applied Science in Banking at St. Petersburg College by submitting the following:

- ❑ Official transcripts showing one of the following:
 - Completion of an A.S. degree from a regionally accredited institution in one of the following business disciplines: International Business, Business Administration, or Financial Services-Banking.
 OR

○ Completion of an A.A. degree from a regionally accredited institution and 15 credits of business support coursework from the following list:

Any lower division courses (1000 or 2000 level) with the MAN prefix	
Any lower division courses (1000 or 2000 level) with the MAR prefix	
Any lower division courses (1000 or 2000 level) with the FIN prefix

Any lower division courses (1000 or 2000 level) with the BRC prefix	
Any lower division courses (1000 or 2000 level) with the BAN prefix

*Note: One lower division BUL course is required as a prerequisite to BRC 3203, which is part of the major.

- ❑ Completion of the following state-mandated prerequisites with a grade of “C” or better:
 - ACG 2021 Financial Accounting
 - ACG 2071 Managerial Accounting
 - CGS 1100 Microcomputer Applications
 - ECO 2013 Principles of Macroeconomics
 - ECO 2023 Principles of Microeconomics
 - MAC 2233 Applied Calculus I
 - STA 2023 Elementary Statistics
- ❑ Official transcripts from high school(s) (or GED). Students who have submitted transcripts documenting a regionally accredited associate or higher degree are not required to submit a high school transcript, unless it documents completion of 2 consecutive years of one foreign language.
- ❑ Official transcripts from college(s) currently or previously attended.
- ❑ Completion of all college preparatory coursework.
- ❑ Completion of a minimum of fifteen (15) semester hours of transferable [general education coursework](#).
- ❑ Cumulative grade point average of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale in all postsecondary coursework.
- ❑ SPC Application
 - New SPC students
 - [Apply for Admission](#) and pay the \$40 application fee.
 - If you have completed an Associate’s Degree, select “BAS” as your degree, and “Banking” as your major.
 - If you have not yet completed an Associate’s Degree, select the appropriate degree (AA or AS) when completing the application. During your final semester of your Associate degree, apply for graduation and submit the “Bachelor Programs” application in MySPC.
 - Returning/Current SPC students
 - Logon to [MySPC](#) and complete the “Bachelor Programs” Application near the bottom of the page. Students who were last enrolled at SPC more than 12 months ago are required to verify their [residency](#) status for tuition purposes.
 - If you have completed an Associate’s Degree, select “BAS” as your degree, and “Banking” as your major. If you have not yet completed an Associate’s Degree, select the appropriate degree (AA or AS) when completing the application. During your final semester of your Associate’s degree, apply for graduation and submit the “Bachelor Programs” application in MySPC.
