Students will be eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Applied Science in Sustainability Management at St. Petersburg College by submitting the following:

- ❑ Official transcripts showing one of the following:
 - Completion of an A.S. degree of sixty (60) credits from a regionally accredited institution in one of the following related disciplines: Environmental Science Technology, Business Management, Architectural Design & Construction Technology, Hospitality & Tourism Management, Accounting, or Engineering Technology.

OR

○ Completion of an A.A. degree from a regionally accredited institution and 15 credits of related coursework (see list below).

- ❑ Official transcripts from college(s) currently or previously attended.
- ❑ Completion of all college preparatory coursework.
- ❑ Completion of a minimum of fifteen (15) semester hours of transferable [general education coursework](#).
- ❑ Cumulative grade point average of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale in all postsecondary coursework.
- ❑ Official transcripts from high school(s) (or GED). Students who have submitted transcripts that document a fully accredited associate's, bachelor's, or higher degree are not required to submit a high school transcript, unless it documents completion of 2 consecutive years of one foreign language.
- ❑ SPC Application
 - New SPC students should

 - Returning SPC students should
 - Logon to [MySPC](#) and complete the Baccalaureate Application by clicking on the "Apply-BS/BAS/ Upper Div Cert" link found in the middle of the page. In addition, students who were last enrolled at SPC more than 12 months ago, are required to verify their residency status by resubmitting the [hard-copy of the general SPC application](#) (the \$40 application fee is waived).
