Financial aid applicants have secure, self-service access to their financial aid records online at MySPC.

To access “**FINANCIAL AID SELF-SERVICE**,” go to www.spcollege.edu and select MySPC. Sign in with your User ID and Password.

AT THE SELF-SERVICE SITE, YOU CAN:

- **VIEW FINANCIAL AID STATUS** – The checklist of items you must complete or documents that must be submitted will be listed on this page. This link also shows whether you meet the Standards of Academic Progress (SAP) you must meet to be eligible for financial aid.
- **VIEW FINANCIAL AID AWARDS** – This link displays the amount of your financial aid awards. If your award total is greater than your term fees, you may use the Book Line of Credit to purchase your books in the Campus Bookstore. Any remaining balance will be credited to your SPCOne account about five weeks after the term begins. Please remember that Federal Work Study must be earned throughout the term and is not disbursed up front. If you have been offered a Federal Direct Stafford loan, you must accept your loan amount online before any money can be disbursed. You will be notified when your student loan funds have been credited to your account.
- **ACCEPT/DECLINE AWARDS** – For your financial aid to be finalized you must read and agree to your rights and responsibilities of financial aid. Your electronic signature is submitted when you click on the button, “**I Agree to These Terms.**”
