Mandatory Health Insurance Verification

Possession of basic health and accident insurance valid outside the U.S., with a benefit limit of at least \$100,000 to cover accident and sickness, emergency medical evacuation and repatriation, is a requirement for participation in a Study Abroad program. The coverage must extend at least three days beyond the final date of the program, in case of an emergency which results in your being in the host country longer than anticipated.

Students traveling abroad must purchase insurance through MEDEX. **It is the student's responsibility to apply for and purchase the minimum coverage as provided above at least 10 days before departure.** MEDEX insurance may be purchased online at www.medexassist.com.
