

# Child Development and Education Articulation

In accordance with the Interinstitutional Articulation Agreement between the Pinellas County Schools' Board of Education and the St. Petersburg College Board of Trustees, this program-to-program agreement provides opportunities for students to receive college credit for appropriate work completed at the Pinellas Technical Education Center. St. Petersburg College agrees to award college credit to Pinellas Technical Education Center graduates as specifically defined above.

A minimum grade point average of 2.0 in the above courses will be required before credit is issued. A grade of "P" will be given for the college credit. Students must enroll at SPC after completing the Early Childhood Education Program with a valid CDA/CDAE to be eligible to receive the articulated credit. This Career Pathways/Tech Prep Articulation Agreement replaces any previously existing agreements relating to the aforementioned program
