



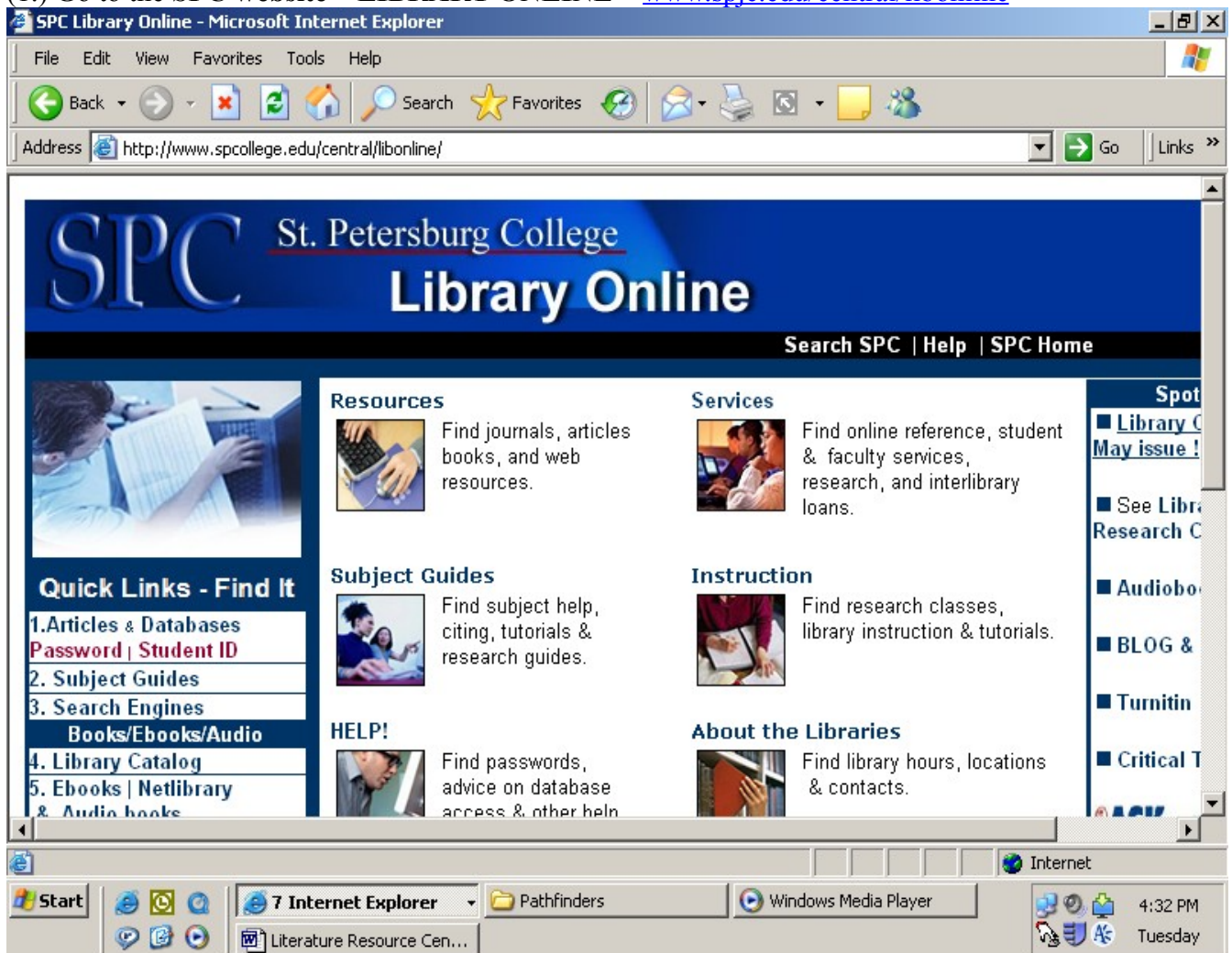

The following are the required STEPS necessary to access the SPC’s Literature Resource Center via the Virtual Library Webpage. This particular database provides accessibility to numerous biographies (information about a person’s life); bibliographies (a listing of works cited or used); plus a critical analysis of author’s writings. Another unique feature is the Literary-Historical Timeline provided that deals with each era of the literary discipline. The timeline consist of works for such great literary periods and/or authors as: *Classical Antiquity, Japanese No Drama, William Shakespeare, Daniel Defoe, Jane Austen, George Eliot, Oscar Wilde, James Joyce, Zora Neale Hurston, Marjorie Kinnon Rawlings, Jack Kerouac and Alice Walker.*

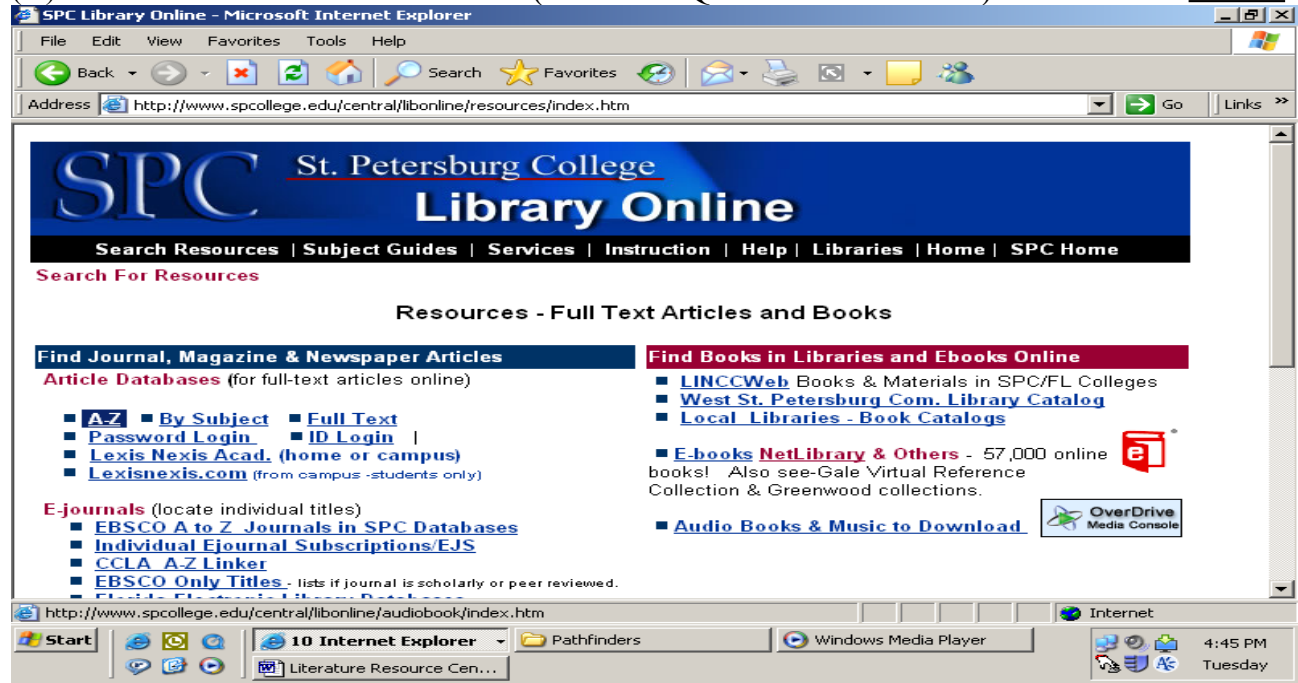
HOW-TO STEPS FOR LITERATURE RESOURCE CENTER

(1.) Go to the SPC website – LIBRARY ONLINE www.spcollege.edu/central/libonline



(2.) Click on **Resources** (*Find journals, articles...*) (see above) 

(3.) Look for **Articles & Databases** (#1 under Quick Links-Find it) and **Click on A – Z.**



(4.) This will take you to the *Alphabetical Listing of Databases* page
Click on the letter **L** (for Literature) or scroll down page to the **L's**



(5.) Enter the **USERNAME: spc** & next enter NEW semester **PASSWORD** _____

DATABASE ACCESS CHOICES are A) Password or B) Borrower Identification:

A) **PASSWORD ACCESS** - Click on link (and enter the User name and Password)

B) **STUDENT ID ACCESS** - Enter your **Borrower ID** [library identification number] and **Pin** number [the last four digits of your social security number]. Click **Log On** button.

(6.) Scroll to the hypertext link **LITERATURE RESOURCE CENTER**
Located under the listing entitled **Arts, Literature & Humanities** and locate:

(7.) Select search category: * **Title** * **Advanced** * **Keyword** * **Authors by Type**
* **Literary-Historical Timeline**, and **TYPE** in your keyword search!!!

(8.) Provided are biographies, literary criticism, articles, work overviews, interviews, websites, etc.
