Pre-Application Requirements

- Completion of [St. Petersburg College Admission Application](#) and the non-refundable fee.
- Completion of the [New Student Orientation](#).
- Completion of the EMT and Paramedic ATD/certificate from a CoAEMSP-accredited and regionally accredited school. **(Students must complete at least twenty five percent of the program courses with an EMS prefix at St. Petersburg College).** [EMS Curriculum](#)
- Submission of all official, unopened (sealed) high school/GED and college transcripts from previously or currently enrolled colleges. Unofficial copies or official copies that have been opened are not acceptable.
- Completion of [placement testing](#) and all college preparatory work. Applicants who have credits earned in mathematics, composition, and/or reading may be waived from the placement test
- If previously or currently enrolled at SPC, academically in good standing and have a cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- Submission of the [Health Programs Application](#).
- Make appointment with EMS Program Director no later than 30-60 days before first class to develop graduation plan.

Pre-Enrollment Requirements

Students offered admission must complete the following pre-enrollment requirements within 90 days prior to the start of the first program course to maintain eligible status:

- Successful passing of a background check and drug screening. [Screening policy criteria](#)
- Completion of the Health Education Examination Form and any required immunizations.
- Attendance at the Student Services Orientation and the Emergency Medical Services Orientation.
