



**LPN-RN Program**

**Admissions Requirements Checklist**

**(Minimum requirements does not guarantee admission)**

- Applications for the Fall term will be accepted beginning March 1<sup>st</sup> until May 15<sup>th</sup>
- Applications for the Spring term will be accepted beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> until September 15<sup>th</sup>
- Applications for the Summer term will be accepted beginning November 1<sup>st</sup> until January 15<sup>th</sup>

**Pre-Application Requirements**

- Complete the [St. Petersburg College Admission Application](#) and the non-refundable fee.
- Complete the [New Student Orientation](#).
- Submit official, unopened (sealed) high school transcript(s) or GED transcript. Unofficial copies or official copies that have been opened are not acceptable. Applicants who have earned an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Baccalaureate, or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution are waived from this requirement.
- Submit all official, unopened (sealed) college transcripts from previously or currently enrolled colleges. Unofficial copies or official copies that have been opened are not acceptable.
- Complete [placement testing](#) and all college preparatory work. Applicants who have credits earned in mathematics, composition, and/or reading may be waived from the placement test
- If previously or currently enrolled at SPC, must be academically in good standing and have a cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- Minimum earned grades of "C" in all general education and support courses. (Excluding the computer competency)
- Students must complete the pre-entry science and support course requirements within three attempts.
- Standard (Scaled Score) of 95 on the Reading subsection of the College Placement Test, 510 SAT Verbal score, 22 ACT Reading score or earn "C" or better in REA 1105, Critical Reading and Thinking, or have earned a Master's or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution.
- Complete 14 credits in the Nursing pre-entry general education and support courses ([LPN-RN Curriculum](#)) with a 2.75 minimum grade point average on a 4.00 scale including PSY1012 General Psychology, Humanities/Fine Arts approved course, [Basic Computer and Information Literacy Competency](#), BSC2085/2085L Human Anatomy and Physiology 1 and Lab and BSC 2086/2086L Human Anatomy and Physiology 2 and Lab.
- Have a 2.75 minimum grade point average on a 4.00 scale in the following courses that are being considered for admission: BSC 2085, BSC 2085L, BSC 2086, BSC 2086L, MCB 2010, and MCB 2010L.
- Submit Florida State LPN license number and issue date with the Health Programs Application.



### **Pre-Enrollment Requirements**

**Students offered admission must complete the following pre-enrollment requirements within 90 days prior to the start of the first program course to maintain eligible status:**

- Successful completion and passing of a background and drug screening. ([Screening policy criteria](#))
- Completion of required immunizations.
- Completion of/attendance at the Student Services Orientation and the Program Orientation.
- Submission of Health Care Provider CPR card.
