Admission Requirements Checklist

- Applications for the Fall term will be accepted beginning March 1<sup>st</sup> until May 15<sup>th</sup>
- Applications for the Spring term will be accepted beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> until September 15<sup>th</sup>

**Pre-Application Requirements**

- Complete the [St. Petersburg College Admission Application](#) and the non-refundable fee.
- Complete the [New Student Orientation](#).
- Submit official, unopened (sealed) high school transcript(s) or GED transcript. Unofficial copies or official copies that have been opened are not acceptable. Applicants who have earned an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Applied Science, Baccalaureate, or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution are waived from this requirement.
- Submit all official, unopened (sealed) college transcripts from previously or currently enrolled colleges. Unofficial copies or official copies that have been opened are not acceptable.
- Complete [placement testing](#) and all college preparatory work. Applicants who have credits earned in mathematics, composition, and/or reading may be waived from the placement test.
- If previously or currently enrolled at SPC, must be academically in good standing and have a cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- Score a 95 on the Reading subsection of the College Placement Test, 510 SAT Verbal score, 22 ACT Reading score, or earn "C" or better in REA 1105, Critical Reading and Thinking, or have earned a Master's or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution.
- Complete PSY1012 General Psychology, [Basic Computer and Information Literacy Competency](#), BSC2085/2085L Human Anatomy and Physiology 1 and Lab and BSC 2086/2086L Human Anatomy and Physiology 2 and Lab with a grade of C or better.
- Earn a 2.75 minimum grade point average on a 4.00 scale in the following courses that are being considered for admission: BSC 2085, BSC 2085L, BSC 2086, BSC 2086L, MCB 2010, and MCB 2010L.
- Earn a 2.75 minimum grade point average on a 4.00 scale in the nursing pre-entry general education and support courses ([Nursing curriculum](#)), Minimum earned grades of "C" in all general education and support courses. (Excluding the computer competency)
- Complete the pre-entry science and support course requirements within three attempts.
- Submit the Health Programs Application.



### **Pre-Enrollment Requirements**

**Students offered admission must complete the following pre-enrollment requirements within 90 days prior to the start of the first program course to maintain eligible status:**

- Successful completion and passing of a background and drug screening. ([Screening policy criteria](#))
- Completion of the Health Examination Form and any required immunizations.
- Completion of/attendance at the Student Services orientation and program orientation.
