SPC No. 1 in online learning

For the fourth time in four years, SPC was named in January 2008 as Florida's leader in distance learning among the state's 28 community colleges. SPC ranked first in the number of courses offered (2,309) and the number of students (16,656).

Banking credit approved

The College of Technology & Management and the Florida Banker's Association have agreed that Florida School of Banking graduates may receive credit toward SPC's accredited baccalaureate degree in banking. The arrangement marks another step in the collaboration between the college and the association, which is aimed at improving the commitment to the education of Florida's bankers. Under the arrangement, a Florida School of Banking graduate enrolling in the St. Petersburg College degree program will receive six credits toward the degree. The credits will be awarded only upon successful completion and graduation from the FSB.
