

Placement testing

Do you need to take the placement test?

All students who want to take credit classes must take the placement test before their first registration unless they fall into one of the following categories:

- Transient student from another accredited college or university.
- Student transferring to St. Petersburg College with sufficient evidence of successful completion of courses in reading, writing and mathematics from the transferring institution.
- Student who has taken the SAT or ACT within the past two years and meets the cut-off score requirement for the specific academic area.
- Non-degree seeking students.

Enrollment in many classes require prerequisite course work or valid test scores regardless of degree seeking status.
