

# Specialized programs/services

## English as a Second Language (ESL) Program -

This collegewide program serves students who are interested in learning to speak, write and comprehend English.

**International Student Services** - Centers at Clearwater, Seminole, St. Petersburg/Gibbs and Tarpon Springs campuses provide information, guidance and support to students from other countries.

**Male Outreach Initiative Program (MOI)** - The Male Outreach Initiative Center works to increase the number of male students at St. Petersburg College through a multiple-tier program that focuses on responsibility, leadership and respect. The goal is to create an environment in which male students may network, gain opportunities, graduate, and find jobs within their respective fields. Additionally, the program is designed to help students with career assessment, mentoring, financial needs and academic support.

## New Initiative Program (NIP) -

Housed in the Caruth Education Center, NIP is an academic support program designed to assist pre-health and health education students. Professional tutors and a variety of multimedia tools are available.



**Office of Services for Students with Disabilities (OSSD)** - Operating on all campuses, these offices carry out SPC's commitment to the open door concept and equal access to educational opportunities for all individuals with qualifying disabilities. Services include academic and career counseling, assistive devices, and special accommodations.

**Student Activities** - Offices are on all campuses to coordinate on-campus events and student clubs and organizations.

**Student Support Services Program (SSS)** - This is a limited-access federally funded TRIO program that provides services to enhance students' academic skills and increase student retention. SSS networks closely with other programs to link students with services that support their academic, social and emotional needs. Located on the Clearwater and St. Petersburg/Gibbs campuses, SSS is open to students from all campuses.

**Women on the Way (WOW)** - This program assists women who are entering or re-entering college. WOW provides scholarships, mentors, counseling, seminars, workshops, housing and child care information, and peer and support groups. WOW is a daytime program headquartered on the Clearwater Campus.
