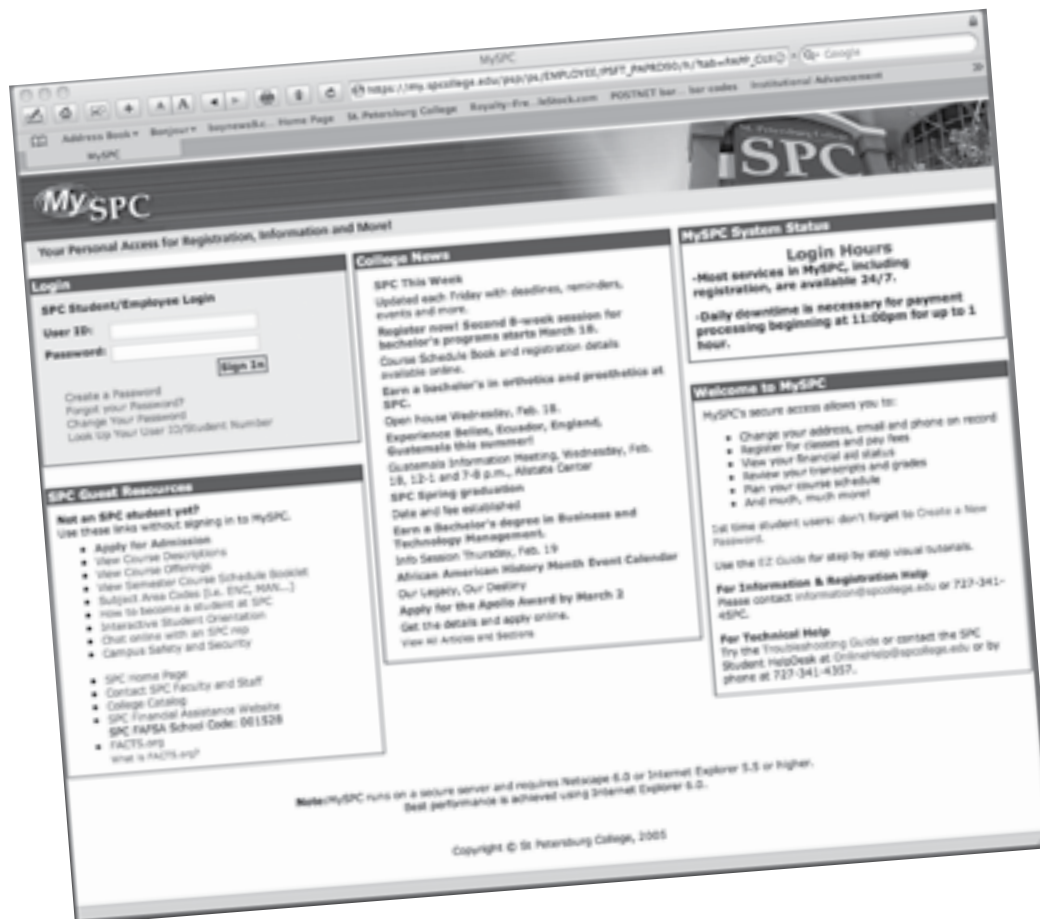

Before you register

First-time students

- Submit application and fee online at www.spcollege.edu or apply in person at any campus.
- Request transcripts from your high school, GED or college be sent to SPC.
- Apply for financial assistance, if desired.
- Using your student ID number as your USER ID, create your MySPC password and set up your student e-mail account.
- Complete the New Student Orientation.
- Take the Computerized Placement Test (CPT), if necessary. For details on the placement test, see page 16.
- Meet with an Academic Advisor.

Returning students

- Go to the “Records” portion of MySPC, review your Degree Progress Report and verify that your degree plan is correct. Contact an academic advisor if changes are needed.
- Apply for financial assistance, if desired.
