

Placement testing

New students seeking a degree who have not completed coursework at another college in English, reading or mathematics are required to take the college's placement test. Those who have taken the SAT or ACT and achieved appropriate scores may be able to use these scores instead of the college's placement test. Check with the Advising Office to determine if this can be done. The placement test includes questions to evaluate your skills in writing, reading comprehension, basic arithmetic and elementary algebra. Additional college-level mathematics skills will be measured if appropriate. The placement test is in a computerized format. The test is not timed; it takes about two hours.

On the day of the test:

- Bring a photo ID with signature.
- Know your student number.
- Calculators, dictionaries, cell phones, pagers, food and drink are not allowed in the assessment area.
