ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The **Training & Development** sub-plan in our Bachelor of Science Degree in Educational Studies and Community Leadership program prepares graduates to fill high-wage, high-demand careers as trainers, evaluators, policy analysts, researchers, and fundraisers working in community programs serving children and families, workforce development, religious centers, rehabilitative services, adult education centers, charities, prisons, and hospitals.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Completion of an Associate in Arts degree or higher *and* a minimum of 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution, including all General Education requirements per St. Petersburg College requirements.
- 2) A cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher (on a 4.00 scale).
