Priority Deadlines

SPC's FAFSA Priority Deadline for Financial Aid Packaging	Oct. 1
Priority Deadline for Admissions Applications and Materials (i.e. transcripts) for Spring Term	Dec. 9

You may still enroll in Spring Term classes if the application is received after this date; however, there is no guarantee transcripts will be evaluated prior to the beginning of Spring Term.

FAS Due Date Extension	March 30
<i>This extension is for students who are awarded a financial aid package by Dec. 14 or Jan. 6. If your financial aid award does not cover the entire balance, you must pay your balance by this date. Students with an extended due date will not be dropped for non-payment by this date. The student may continue in the class, but will be billed for the amount owed. Future registration and official transcripts will not be available until the balance is paid in full.</i>

Awarding Verification	Financial aid awarding occurs DAILY, email notifications are sent DAILY 14 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation <i>Once complete, the verification item(s) will be removed from your MySPC To Do List.</i>
SAP Appeals	15 working days from the receipt date of all required documentation, email notifications are sent DAILY <i>Once a decision is made, the SAP item will be removed from your MySPC To Do List. To check the current SAP status, login to MySPC, select "Financial Aid Status," select the aid year and look in the box in the top right-hand corner.</i>

Students will be notified by email if, during peak processing times, the benchmarks above have been revised.
