



## Criteria for Determining Eligibility for the Fuse program at SPC:

- **High school graduates (First Time in College)**
  - Interest in approved USF major ---see approved majors <http://www.spcollege.edu/fuse>
  - Degree seeking and enrolled in classes at SPC
  - Ability to complete the AA degree, with pre-requisites, in 3 years with SPC
  - Enrolled full time (no less than ¾ time) fall and spring
  - High school GPA is not required for admission (follow SPC admissions policy)
  - **Regular advising appointments with SPC/USF advisors**
  
- **Current SPC Students**
  - Interest in approved USF major ---see approved majors <http://www.spcollege.edu/fuse>
  - 2.0. or higher GPA (unless otherwise posted on the pathways)
  - Ability to complete the AA degree, with pre-requisites, within 3 years at SPC
  - Enrolled full time (no less than ¾ time) fall and spring
  - Declare FUSE intent no later than 30 credit hours
  - In good academic standing at SPC
  - **Regular advising appointments with SPC/USF advisors**
  
- **Dual Enrolled Students **ARE** eligible for FUSE**
  - Must have less than 30 credits after high school graduation to join FUSE
  - Must have earned a 2.0 GPA in Dual enrollment courses
  - Must be in good academic standing at SPC
  
- **Early Admissions Students –case by case-**
  - Students with 36 college credits or less **and** on path for the fuse major, may be eligible
  - Over 36 college credits, they are not eligible
  
- **Early College and Collegiate High School Students **ARE NOT** eligible for FUSE**
  - students earn their AA degree and are over 30 college credits after high school graduation
