

**Associate in Science Degree in Nursing (ASN) options at SPC**  
**(Beginning Fall 2026)**

SPC offers several options for completing the ASN degree so you can choose the one that best fits your lifestyle.

## Traditional ASN — Theory/Sim Schedule Tracks:

Please Note: NUR 1110C – Health Concepts I includes Theory, Simulation and Clinical; each are on-campus course sections and held as noted per schedule option below:

### 1. Morning Track with Weekday Clinicals

- Four consecutive semesters (17 months)
- Theory is in the morning (usually 8am-1pm) - 1 day per week + online coursework
- Simulation is in the morning (usually 7am-1pm) - 1 day every other week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week (M-F, varies) approx. 6am-5pm.
- **Fall and Spring admission**

### 2. Afternoon Track with Weekday Clinicals

- Four consecutive semesters (17 months)
- Theory is in the afternoon (usually 1pm-6pm) - 1 day per week + online coursework
- Simulation is in the afternoon (usually 12:30pm to 6:30pm) – 1 day every other week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week (M-F, varies) from approx. 6am – 5pm
- **Fall and Spring admission**

### 3. Summer Afternoon Track – Clinical Days Vary - Weekday/Weekend

- Five consecutive semesters (17 months) – practicum completed during 1<sup>st</sup> 8-weeks of 5<sup>th</sup> term
- Theory is in the afternoon (usually 1pm-6pm) – 1 day per week + online coursework
- Simulation is in the afternoon (usually 12:30pm-6:30pm) – 1 day per week
- Online simulations – 1 day per week, various weeks
- On-Campus Clinicals weeks 1-3 - 2 days per week (M-Sa, varies) from approx. 7am – 1pm
- Clinicals weeks 4-9 – 1 day per week (M-Sa, varies) from approx. 6:30am-2:30pm
- **Summer admission**

### 4. Evening/Weekend Track with Weekend Clinicals (Not Available for Paramedics)

- Six consecutive semesters (2 years)
- Theory is in the evening (usually 5pm-9pm) – 1 day per week + online coursework
- Simulation is in the evening (usually 5pm-8pm) – 1 day per week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week on Saturdays from approx. 6am - 5pm
- **Fall and Spring admission**

### 5. Paramedic-RN Track

- Follow traditional morning/afternoon tracks, evening/weekend track is not available for Paramedic-RN students.

# LPN-RN Transitional — Theory/Sim Schedule Tracks:

Please Note: NUR 1003C – LPN Transition Health Concepts includes Theory, Simulation and Clinical; each are on-campus course sections and held as noted per schedule option below:

This is for students who have completed their LPN at an accredited school and hold a valid LPN license in the State of Florida.

## 6. Afternoon (Day) Track with Weekday Clinicals

- Three semesters with summer off (Fall, Spring, Fall)
- Theory is in the afternoon (usually 1pm-6pm) - 1 day per week + online coursework
- Simulation is in the afternoon (usually 12:30pm – 6:30pm) - 1 day every other week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week (M-F, varies) from approx. 6am - 5pm
- **Fall admission only.**

## 7. Evening Track with Weekend Clinicals

- Three semesters with summer off (Spring, Fall, Spring)
- Theory is in the evening (usually 5pm - 9pm) - 1 day per week + online coursework
- Simulation is in the evening (usually 5pm - 8pm) - 1 day every week
- Clinicals are 1 day per week on Saturdays from approx. 6am - 5pm
- **Spring admission only**
