 - The accuracy of your Social Security number and date of birth are **CRITICAL** as it is used for verification.
- Pinellas County School students must also know their Pinellas County School ID.
 - Private and home-education students do **NOT** need a PCS identification number to apply.
- 1. Complete the online application to receive an SPC student ID number at https://www.spcollege.edu/future-students/admissions
 - a. Click on High School Programs Student.
 - b. Follow the directions to complete your application.
 - c. Once your application is completed, you will receive your SPC student number and e-mail address.
 - Please retain a copy of this information.
 - d. The \$40 application fee will be waived at time of registration.
- 2. Activate student account.
 - a. Go to the Titan's Login located at <u>www.spcollege.edu</u>.
 - b. Choose Create Password and follow the steps.
 - Do<u>NOT</u> choose to change password.
 - If you have any issues, please contact SPC Technical Support at (727) 341-4357.
- 3. Take the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT).

Note: Skip this step if you have qualifying PSAT, SAT or ACT scores. To make a testing appointment please use the following link: <u>https://www.spcollege.edu/future-students/admissions/testing</u>

- a. Each student will have <u>only</u> two attempts per semester and one attempt during the summer.
- b. Students are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED to prepare prior to testing.
- c. It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED to complete all testing a week before the application deadline.

- 4. Complete Early College Application.
 - a. Complete online application at https://web.spcollege.edu/survey/37182
 - b. You **MUST** upload a PDF copy of your test scores to the application for it to be considered complete.
 - c. The application cannot be saved. Be sure to have your scores ready before you begin the application.
- 5. Priority Application **MUST** be submitted by 11:59 pm on January 10, 2025, to be considered.
 - a. All admission eligibility criteria must be met by the submission deadline.
 - b. If we have fewer eligible applicants than seats, all applicants will be invited to the program.
 - c. If we have more eligible applicants than seats, we will do a random selection to determine who is invited and place the remaining students on a waitlist.
 - d. Acceptance/notification e-mails will be sent no later than January 27, 2025.
- 6. Final Application **MUST** be submitted by 11:59 pm on February 10, 2025.
 - a. All admission eligibility criteria must be met by the submission deadline.
 - b. All eligible applicants between January 11th and February 10th will be placed in a randomized order to invite to fill open seats and/or added to the waitlist.
 - c. Acceptance/notification e-mails will be sent no later than February 17, 2025.
 - d. A commitment to attend the Early College program must be received by 2:00 pm on February 21, 2025.

Before an out-of-district student can apply for the Early College program, a Pinellas County Special Attendance Permit must be approved. Students with special attendance Permits will be considered for seats remaining after all PCS applicants have been placed.
