ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The St. Petersburg College Bachelor of Science degree in Educational Studies & Community Leadership offers an Educational Interpreting sub-plan. All education classes are offered both online and face-to-face with a specific sequence of classes held at the Clearwater Campus. This combination of course delivery modes was designed to suit the needs of our working students and will allow for creative scheduling.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

1) Completion of an Associate in Arts degree or higher *and* a minimum of 60 credits from a regionally accredited institution, including all General Education requirements per St. Petersburg College requirements.

2) Complete the following state-mandated prerequisite courses with a grade of 'C' or higher:

- o ASL 1140C Basic American Sign Language with Lab
- o ASL 1150C Intermediate American Sign Language with Lab
- o ASL 1160C Advanced American Sign Language with Lab
- o ASL 2210C American Sign Language IV with Lab o ASL 1300 Structure of American Sign Language o ASL 1510 Introduction to Deaf Culture
- 3) A cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher (on a 4.00 scale).

FRESHMAN
